This 9-month contract position (March-November) involves working closely with the Camp Director to ensure smooth daily operations and exceptional experiences for campers and staff alike. Key Responsibilities

- Leadership and Supervision
 - Oversee daily camp operations, providing on-site supervision and serving as the primary point of contact in the Director's absence
 - Ensure adherence to Standards of Practice across all program areas
 - Foster a safe, positive, and inclusive environment for campers and staff
 - Collaborate with the Camp Director on problem-solving and staff development initiatives

Program Management

- Lead the development and implementation of creative, fun, and safe camp programs
- Continuously evaluate and improve program offerings
- Ensure all activities align with camp values and industry standards
- Staff Management
 - Assist in training, and supervising camp staff
 - Provide mentorship and support to team members
 - Conduct performance evaluations and address any staff-related issues
- Risk Management and Safety
 - Maintain a strong focus on camper and staff safety
 - Implement and enforce safety protocols across all camp activities
 - Respond promptly and effectively to any emergencies or incidents

Qualifications

- 3+ years experience in senior positions in Recreation, Camp or Program management
- Proven track record in program development and staff supervision
- Strong leadership, communication, and problem-solving skills
- Ability to work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends
- Current standard first aid or wilderness first aid

- Advanced ropes course certifications Level 1, level 2 or Challenge Course Manager (CCM) (or significant experience so that the individual can fast track to complete the CCM training)
- National Lifesaving Society qualifications (guarding and instructing)

- Outdoor education experience

Work Environment

- Live on-site from May to October
- Remote work possible during off-season months (March-April, November)

Compensation

- Pro-rated to a \$50,000 annual salary (plus 4% vacation pay). This base salary will be increased if the successful applicant has their Challenge Course Manager already.
- On-site private or shared accommodations plus meals/snacks when provided for groups at no cost from late April until late October.
